

Online Proctoring Tips: Set Yourself Up for Success

When you prepare for an online exam appointment with PSI, here are two key reminders to help ensure a smooth testing experience:

- Use a Wired Internet Connection: We strongly recommend connecting your computer to the internet using an Ethernet cable. While Wi-Fi may work for everyday tasks, it often isn't stable enough to support the technical demands of the ARE. A wired connection offers the reliability you need to avoid disruptions during your exam. NCARB will not provide a refund or seat credit for exams disrupted due to internet connectivity issues.
- Run a Test Run Before Every Appointment: Before each online proctored
 exam, be sure to complete a system test run even if you've done one in the
 past. Technical issues can arise at any time, especially with updates to your
 computer or testing software or when testing in a new location. Please note
 that NCARB does not provide seat credits for issues that could have been
 identified during a test run.
